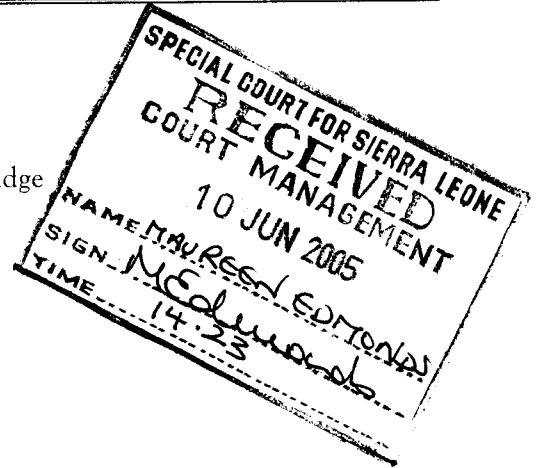


FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,
