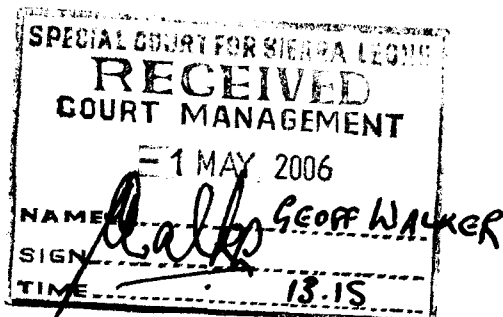


I. INTRODUCTION

1. On 25 April 2006, the second Accused filed the 'Public Fofana Admissions of Fact and Statement of Matters not in Dispute'¹ ("Statement of Admissions").
2. The Prosecution is in agreement with the Defence and admits the following paragraphs from the Statement of Admissions:
 - paragraph 2 (a), paragraph 2 (b), paragraph 2 (c) and paragraph 2 (h).
3. The Prosecution is not in agreement with the Defence and does not admit the following paragraphs from the Statement of Admissions:
 - paragraph 2 (d), paragraph 2 (e), paragraph 2 (f) and paragraph 2 (g).
4. The Prosecution will continue to work with the Defence in order to further identify agreed points of law and facts reached by the parties in accordance with the 'Consequential Order to the Status Conference of 22 March 2006'.²
