

1. On 26 April 2006, the Trial Chamber issued its "Order for Disclosure pursuant to Rule 73ter and the Start of the Defence Case" ("**Order**"). <sup>1</sup>

2. On the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2006, the Trial Chamber issued it's order that the summary of the evidence of the 1<sup>st</sup> Accused person – Tamba Brima be filed by 4pm on Friday

19<sup>th</sup> May 2006.<sup>2</sup>

3. Prior to May 17 2006 the accused Mr. Brima had indicted his intention to provide a written statement which Counsel would have used as a bases for preparing a summary of his proposed evidence for filing, in compliance with the order made

by the Court on May 17 2006.

4. Pursuant to the Court order of 17 May, the Counsel conducted follow up consultation with the accused in respect of his written statement. Unfortunately however, the Accused informed Counsel of his unwillingness to provide a written statement or summary of his testimony based on the presumption of his innocence and his fundamental rights to remain silent, recognising that any written statement

of his testimony may be used in evidence against him.

5. The Defence team hereby accordingly informs the Court of the decision of the

First Accused.
