

SITTING as the Trial Chamber composed of Judge Bankole Thompson, Presiding Judge, Judge Benjamin Mutanga Itoe and Judge Pierre Boutet;

BEING SEIZED of three (3) motions filed by the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") on 9 October 2003 for joinder of the trials of the Accused in Prosecutor v Sam Hinga Norman (Case No.SCSL-2003-08-PT), Prosecutor v Moinina Fofana (Case No.SCSL-2003-11-PT), Prosecutor v Allieu Kondewa (Case No.SCSL-2003-12-PT);

CONSIDERING its Decision and Order on the Prosecutor Motion for Joinder ("Decision"), rendered orally on 27 January 2004;
