- 1. The 26 May 2008 the Trial Chamber issued the "Decision on Prosecution Request for Clarification of Status of DMK-400 and DMK-422."
- 2. In this Decision the Chamber ordered that the name of DMK-444 be disclosed and that the redacted portion of the witness transcript with the name of the said witness DMK-444 be unredacted.²
- 3. The Kallon Defence refers to the transcripts of 19 May 2008: The Defence applied under Rule 79(A)(iii) that witness DMK-444 testify in closed session, based on fact that the United Nations waived the immunity of the witness on the condition that he testifies in closed session. The Chamber granted the application.³
- 4. The Defence seeks clarification from the Chamber on the order to disclose the name of DMK-444 and that the redacted portion of the transcript with the name of the witness be unredacted, as this goes contrary to the ruling of the Chamber on 19 May 2008.
