- On 8 October 2003 the Defence filed 'Application to Stay Determination of All Preliminary Motions – Denial of Right to Appeal'. ("Kallon Application")
 The Defence Application joined and adopted the submissions made on behalf of Hinga Norman in 'Defence Application to Stay Determination of All Preliminary Motions – Denial of Right to Appeal' filed 2 October 2003 ("Norman Application").
