I, Justice Jon M. Kamanda, Presiding Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ('Special Court');

RECALLING that in accordance with Article 2 of the Agreement Between the United Nations and the Government of Sierra Leone on the Establishment of a Special Court for Sierra Leone, ('Agreement')<sup>1</sup> and Article 12 of the Statute of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ('Statute') Hon. Justice Philip Nyamu Waki was appointed as an Alternate Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the Special Court, the said appointment commencing on 20 January 2012;

NOTING in particular the provisions of Article 2(5) of the Agreement and of Article 12(4) of the Statute which provide that:

If, at the request of the President of the Special Court, an alternate judge or judges have been appointed by the Government of Sierra Leone or the Secretary General, the presiding judge of a Trial Chamber or the Appeals Chamber shall designate such an alternate judge to be present at each stage of the trial and to replace a judge if that judge is unable to continue sitting;

**NOTING** also the provisions of Rule 16bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Special Court for Sierra Leone ('Rules');

PURSUANT TO Article 12(4) of the Statute and Rule 16bis;

**HEREBY DESIGNATE** Hon. Justice Philip Nyamu Waki, to be present at each stage of the proceedings and deliberations of the Appeals Chamber in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Charles Ghankay Taylor*; and to perform such other functions within the Appeals Chamber as the Presiding Judge in consultation with the other judges of the Chamber may deem necessary.
