Whereas by subsection (1) of Section 84 of the Constitution it is provided that a Session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Sierra Leone and shall commence at such time as the President may by Proclamation appoint:

Now, Therefore, I, Ahmad Tejan Kabbah, President of the Republic of Sierra Leone, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice do by this Proclamation prorogue Parliament with effect from Thursday, the 21st day of May, 1998 and do further proclaim that the Second Session of the First Parliament of the Second Republic shall be held at Parliament Building, Tower Hill, commencing on Friday, the 22nd day of May, 1998 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Sierra Leone at the State House, Freetown, this 12th day of May, in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-eight.
