C A P. XLIV.

An Act for transferring to His Majesty, certain Poffessions and Rights vested in the Sierra Leone Company, and for shortening the Duration of the faid Company, and for preventing any dealing or trafficking in the buying or felling of Slaves within the Colony of Sierra Leone. [8th August 1807.]

THEREAS by an Act, passed in the Thirty-first Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for establishing a 31 G.3. c.82. Company for carrying on Trade between the Kingdom of Great recited, which Britain and the Coasts. Harbours, and Countries of Africa, and for enabling transferred certain Pofthe faid Company to hold by Grant from His Majesty, His Heirs, and Suc- fessions of ceffors, and from the Native Princes of Africa, a certain District of Land, His Majesty commonly called The Peninfula of Sierra Leone, now vested in His Majesty to the Sierra or belonging to the said Princes, for the better enabling the said Company to Leone Comcarry on the said Trade, it was amongst other Things enacted, That the pany. feveral Persons therein named and described should be, and they were thereby created one diffinct and separate Body Politic and Corporate, by the Name or Stile of The Sierra Leone Company; and it was also enacted, That it should be lawful for His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors to make unto the faid Company a Grant, by Letters Patent under the Great Seal of Great Britain, of so much and such Part of all that Tract or District of Land, situate and being at Sierra Leone on the Coast of Africa, and commonly called or known by the Name or Description of The Peninfula of Sierra Leone, as then already might have, or should thereafter, by any Grant, Purchase, or Cession from any of the Kings, Princes, or Chiefs, having Right, become vested in His Majesty, His Heirs or

Successors, with Power and Liberty to and for the said Company to purchase of and from all Kings, Princes, and Chiefs, or other Persons having Right to make Sale thereof, so much Land as should include the whole Tract or District so commonly called or known by the Name of The Peninfula of Sierra Leone as aforefaid to hold the fame to the faid Company and their Affigns, upon fuch Terms, Conditions, and Refervations, as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, should judge expedient; and it was thereby further enacted, That the faid Act fhould take place and have continuance from the First Day of July One thousand seven hundred and ninety-one, for the Term of Thirty-one Years, and from thence to the End of the next Session of Parliament: And whereas by Letters Patent, bearing Date the Fifth Day of July in the Forty-first Year of His Majesty's Reign, His Majesty, by virtue and in pursuance of the said Act, did give and grant unto the faid Company, their Successors and Assigns, the aforefaid Tract and Diffrict of Land, with Liberty and Privilege to purchase Lands in addition thereto as aforesaid, all which Lands His Majesty by the faid Letters Patent did make, erect, and create one independent and feparate Colony, by the Name of The Colony of Sierra Leone, and did ordain, will, and establish, that the Court of Directors of the faid Company affembled for that Purpose should and might make, enact, and declare Laws, Statutes, and Ordinances fit and necessary for and concerning the Government of the faid Colony, and might appoint a Governor and Council for the Government of the faid Colony; and His Majesty did give and grant that there should be within the Town of Free Town one Body Politic and Corporate, by the Name and Stile of The Mayor and Aldermen of Free Town, with Power to hold a Court of Record, by the Name of The Mayor's Court of Free Town, and divers other Officers to affift in the Administration of Justice, and in the Government of the faid Colony, under the Superintendance and Controll of the Court of Directors of the faid Company: And whereas the faid Company, convinced of the Expediency of relinquishing the Government and Management of the faid Colony, have expressed a Defire to make, and have humbly intreated His Majesty to accept a Surrender to His Majesty of all the Tract or Diffrict of Land granted to them by the faid Letters Patent, or of which the faid Company are possessed, or which they do now enjoy by Purchase or otherwise, in Addition to the said Lands so granted to the faid Company; and they are further defirous that their Existence as a Body Politick and Corporate should cease and determine within such Period of Time, fhorter than that limited and declared in and by the faid Statute, as is deemed by the faid Company fufficient for them to fettle their Affairs; for confirming and giving Effect to fuch intended Surrender, and for limiting the Duration of the faid Company: May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the Patent grant- faid Letters Patent and Grant, and every Matter, Claufe, and Thing therein ing fuch Pof- contained, shall, and the same are hereby declared to be henceforth null and void; and the faid Company shall be, and they are hereby divested he void, and the fame shall of and from all that Tract or District of Land commonly called and known by the Name or Description of The Peninsula of Sierra Leone, and all Forts, Caftles, Buildings, or Estate, which have been fince pur-

chased or otherwise acquired by the said Company in addition thereto, or which now are poffeffed or claimed by the faid Company in or about the faid Peninfula; and the faid Tract or District of Land, and all Forts, Caftles, Buildings, or Estate so purchased or otherwise acquired, possessed, enjoyed, or claimed by the faid Company, shall henceforth be, and the fame and every of them are and is hereby declared and enacted to be fully and absolutely vested in His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, for ever.

II. And be it further enacted, That, at the Expiration of Seven Years At the Exfrom and after the passing of this Act, the said Sierra Leone Company piration of Seven Years, shall cease to be a Body Politick and Corporate, to all Intents, Constructhe Sierra tions, and Purpofes whatfoever; any Thing in the faid Act to the con- Leone Comtrary thereof in anywife notwithstanding.

III. And be it further enacted, That in case any Difference shall arise litie &c. respecting any Building or Buildings as aforesaid, whether the same is or are fuch as within the Meaning of this Act are to be furrendered by the faid Company, and vested in His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, it shall determine and may be lawful for the Governor that shall be appointed by His Majesty Buildings are for the Government of the faid Colony, or in his Absence for the Lieute- to be furnant Governor, and he is hereby authorized and required, after due rendered and Examination of the Matter, to determine whether any fuch Building or vefted in His Buildings is or are to be furrendered and vested in His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, or to remain in the Possession of the said Company; and fuch Determination shall be final.

IV. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That it shall not be Dealing in lawful for any Person or Persons whatsoever, inhabiting, or being, or who Slaves in the shall at any Time hereafter inhabit or be within the faid Peninfula or Sierra Leone Colony of Sierra Leone, either directly or indirectly, to deal or traffick in, prohibited. buy or fell, or to be aiding or affifting in the dealing or trafficking in the buying or felling of Slaves, either within the faid Peninfula or elfewhere.
